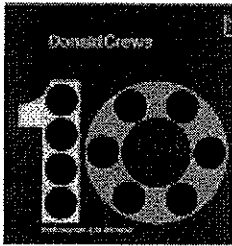

Select TWO of the following books for you to read to your child or for your child to read to you over the summer.



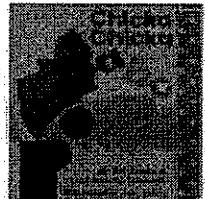
